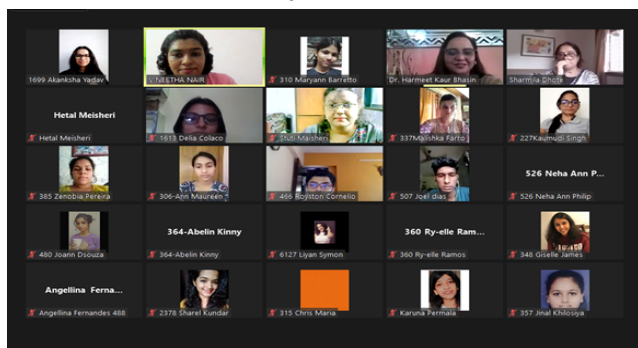


College Women Development Cell (CWDC)

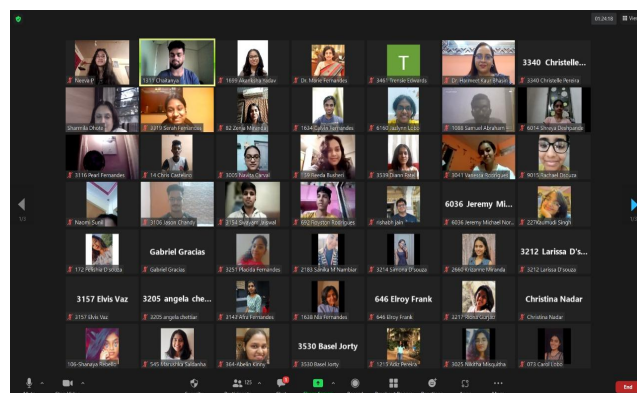
'Awareness on Women's Rights' | 24th September 2021
