Conducted 'Kerala Donation Drive' on 23rd & 24th August, 2018 in association with the NSS & AICUF Departments. The proceeds were donated to the people affected by the cyclone in Kerala, by 'The Kerala Catholic Association, Mumbai (Virar Unit)'.

The Field coordinator for DLLE came to conduct the First Term Training programme on 08th September, 2018. The students were given a brief overview of DLLE. He also briefed on the Rules, Regulations, and Policies of DLLE.

On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti more than 100 students of DLLE participated in the Juhu Beach Clean – Up, an activity organized by "Mission Green, Mumbai (NGO)" on 02nd October, 2018.

The Joy of Giving Week was conducted from 14th to 20th December, 2018 by the BAF department. The DLLE students too actively contributed in the Drive. The proceeds were donated to Orphanages & Old Age Homes in Mumbai.

On 21st December, 2018 students visited, Parash Dnyan Shikshan Prasarak Mandal (Mira Road), Swagat Ashram Charitable Trust (Malad West) & Amcha Ghar (Uttan) with their collections (Food, stationery, toiletries etc.) and spent time with the under privileged children & old people thus spreading the Joy of Christmas.

On 23rd December, 2018 more than 80 students participated in "HOSH Walkathon" - A walk towards Healthy Organic Future at Shivaji Park, Dadar.

A Poster Making Competition was arranged on 29th January, 2019 for all the DLLE students from the college. The best poster got a cash prize and the winner was sent for the Udaan Festival held on 1st February, 2019. 20 Students participated in the Street Play of the same festival. The festival was organised by the Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension, University of Mumbai and took place at M.V.M College of Commerce & Science, Andheri (W). They were accompanied by Prof. Savina Shenoy & Prof. Jill Lobo. This year our college won 1st Prize for Poster making competition in Udaan Festival.

On 2nd February, 2019 Two Workshops were conducted for DLLE & Non – DLLE Students of college. The first workshop was on Time Management by CA Hrudyesh Pankhania in which around 90 students participated and second was on Self Defence by Dr. Chhaya Shah in which around 50 girls participated.

On 03rd February, 2019 more than 50 students volunteered for Marathon organised by Goregaon Sports Club, on the occasion of World Cancer Day at Goregaon Sports Club. The amount collected through Marathon was utilized for the cancer patients in many hospitals.

The CP & APY Students jointly went to Carter Road on 21st February, 2019 to teach underprivileged kids. They also distributed Biscuits to those kids.

On 03rd March, 2019 more than 30 students volunteered for "Run for Humanity" Marathon organised by Lions Club of Andheri, for social cause. The amount collected through Marathon was utilized for donating food to various NGO's in Mumbai.

On 08th March, 2019 DLLE students celebrated Women's Day with Class 3 & Class 4 employees of the college.

The CP (Career Project) students have visited various schools, colleges and orphanages to educate, empower & enlighten underprivileged students through education.

The SWS (Survey of Women's Status) students conducted Women's survey in areas allocated to them by the Extension Teacher. A Summary report is written and data analysis is done at the end of the year on the basis of the data collected by the students.

For the APY (Anna Poorna Yojna) students were put into group of 3-4. They have already put up food stalls during the Annual Sports Day, Joy of Giving Week and Celebrate Christmas. At the end of the term, the profit from these stalls is donated to NGO's.

The students who did not participate in the Udaan Festival wrote essay of 1500 words on the topic out of list of 42 topics given by the Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension, University of Mumbai in addition to the final assignments given.
