**INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE FAREWELL PROGRAM FOR THIRD YEAR  
STUDENTS (AIDED AND SELF-FINANCED COURSES)**

**29 APRIL 2026**

To ensure a disciplined, respectful, and enjoyable event, the following rules will be strictly enforced for all attendees.

**Dress Code:**

Theme Colours: Blue and/or Black

Formal wear only. Boys must wear a formal suit.

**Prohibited clothing for girls includes the following:**

- Dresses above the knee or dresses with slits, deep necklines, or backless designs.
- Sleeveless dresses and jackets.
- Stockings or black net overlays on short dresses.
- Shawls or stoles to cover sleeveless or backless dresses.
- Makeup items such as lipstick, lip gloss, foundation, eyeliner, compact, etc.

**Prohibited clothing for boys includes the following:**

- Shorts, sleeveless outfits, casual wear, or any attire deemed informal.

**Prohibited Items:**

- Items such as vapes, cigarettes, alcohol, sharp objects, drugs, or any illegal items.

**Items Permitted:**

- Wallets
- ID cards
- Event passes
- Phones
- Bags and purses

**Security Checks and Entry Regulations**

- Frisking will be conducted at the entry point.
- Bags and purses will be thoroughly checked.
- Any suspicious or restricted items found will result in the immediate dismissal of the student, and strict action will be taken.
- Students will not be allowed to enter without a valid ID card and Event Pass
- Dress code violations will result in denial of entry, and no refunds will be issued.



### Wristband Policy

- A wristband will be provided to attendees upon entry.
- The allocation of food, souvenirs, and other amenities will be strictly dependent on the wristband.
- Attendees are required to wear the wristband and take care of it throughout the event, making sure it is intact and not damaged.

### Exit and Washroom Policy

- Once you enter, you will not be allowed to exit and re-enter.

### Behavioural Rules

- Attendees must follow all instructions given by the event organisers and security personnel.
- Attendees must maintain a respectful and decorous demeanour at all times.

### Consequences of Rule Violations

Immediate removal from the event for

- any non-compliance of the stated rules
- inappropriate behaviour
- possession of prohibited items
- violation of the college dress code
