AIDED & SFC APAAR ID / ABC ID CREATION & LINKING WITH UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI SAMARTH PORTAL

All students are hereby informed that the University of Mumbai has arranged an AADHAAR Facilitation Camp to assist students with APAAR ID, ABC ID linking, Aadhaar authentication and other Aadhaar-related issues.

Students who have not yet created their ABC ID / APAAR ID or whose ABC ID is not linked with the University of Mumbai Samarth Portal should complete the process at the earliest.

STEPS TO COMPLETE ABC ID

Step 1 – Create / Check APAAR ID (ABC ID)

Students should ensure that their APAAR ID / ABC ID is created using their correct details.

Step 2 – Check Aadhaar Details

Students must ensure that their name, date of birth and mobile number are correctly updated and match their academic records. The University camp will also assist with name/DOB mismatch and mobile-number mismatch issues.

Step 3 – Keep ABC ID Details Ready

After creation of the ABC ID, students should keep their ABC ID number safely and provide the correct number to the College whenever required.

Step 4 – ABC ID Linking with University of Mumbai Samarth

Students should log in to their University of Mumbai Samarth student account and complete the ABC ID-related details/linking wherever the option is available.

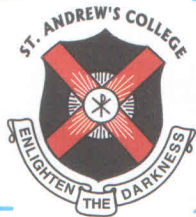
Step 5 – Verify with College

After completing the process, students should ensure that their ABC ID is correctly mapped/linked with their University student record through the College/University system.

IMPORTANT

Students having any of the following problems should attend the special facilitation camp:

- ABC ID / APAAR ID not created
- ABC ID not linked
- Aadhaar authentication problem
- Mobile number mismatch
- Name mismatch
- Date of Birth (DOB) mismatch
- Other Aadhaar/APAAR/ABC ID-related issues



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Students should complete their ABC ID creation and linking process without delay before 19th August 2026, as APAAR ID and ABC ID are important components of the academic credit and student record system. This is mandatory for all the students failing which students will be responsible for any further consequences.

If any technical issue need to be addressed then students should attend the following Aadhaar Facilitation Camp.

Why is this important?

As per the National Education Policy (NEP), every student must have an  Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID.

This guide will help you easily create your Samarth Portal login and link your ABC ID.

Part 1: Create Your Samarth Portal Login

1.  Visit **<https://mu.samarth.edu.in>**
2.  Select your Program
3.  Enter your Name exactly as per Mumbai University registration
4.  Enter your Enrollment Number (ENR No.)
5.  Enter the captcha and click Submit
6.  Check your registered Email ID for the OTP and verify it
7.  Create a new password and remember it for future use

Part 2: Create / Link Your ABC ID

8.  Login to the Samarth Portal
9.  Click on Create/Link Your Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) Account
10.  Click the blue button: Click here to link/create your ABC Account
11.  Select Aadhaar as the option
12.  Enter your Aadhaar Number and click Next
13.  Enter the OTP received on your Aadhaar-linked mobile number
14.  Give consent by selecting the checkboxes and click Allow
15.  You will see the message: ABC Details Submitted

16.  Login to the College Samarth Portal
17.  Open: <https://mu.samarth.ac.in/index.php/student/programme/all>
18.  Click Export the List and choose Excel 2007+
19.  Open the downloaded Excel file
20.  Check the ABCID column to confirm student ABC IDs
