## **Seminars Held**

Amongst its various initiatives, the Research Committee organised,

- 1. Session on **'IPR in Academic Settings'** by Mr. Savio D'souza on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2019 for the staff and students of the college. 21 faculty members and 34 students attended this session.
- 2. A two-day national workshop on **"Research Methodology and Data Analysis in Social Sciences"** in collaboration with the All-India Association for Christian Higher Education on 27-28<sup>th</sup> February, 2020.

The workshop included participants from humanities, management and business background. The event began with an inaugural session by lighting the lamp by Dr. Fr. George Thadathil SDB – President of AIACHE along with Dr. Marie Fernandes – Principal of St. Andrew's College. Dr. Anagha Tendulkar, Associate Professor, Sophia College, Mumbai conducted the session on 'An overview on research methods and techniques'. Ms. Neelam Rajan Chavan, Librarian of Guru Nanak Khalsa College conduced a practical session on 'Practical session on search engine optimization'. 3. An online one-day national conference on the topic "Publication Ethics and Research Visibility" on 19<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

Research committee in collaboration with Library committee conducted a webinar titled 'Publication Ethics and Research Visibility' on 19 March 2021. More than 130 participants from all over India participated in the conference. The participants included teachers, librarians, research scholars, and students from various parts of India.

The session conducted by Dr. Subhasree Nag of Clarivate, Bangalore was on the topic 'Take your Research to the Next Level – Web of Science'. She deliberated on the relevance of journal impact factor and how to select a good journal for publication. Further, she displayed the Web of science master journal list and urged participants to use this list for the selection of journals for publication.

Dr. Sushama Powdwal, former University Librarian of SNDT Women's University, Mumbai, discussed the importance of Ethics in Research and Publication in her session on 'Publication Ethics and UGC CARE list. The former part of her session focussed on plagiarism, (types of plagiarism including self-plagiarism), importance of academic integrity and informed consent in research and publication misconduct. The latter part included a detailed explanation on the genesis of UGC CARE list, registration on the UGC CARE list site, and listing of journals and how to search in the list.

Dr. Sarika Sawant, Assistant Professor, SHPT School of Library Science, SNDT Women's University, Mumbai discussed the importance of research visibility for scholars. Her session was titled 'Build Your Academic Presence: Importance of Research Visibility in the Online Era'.
