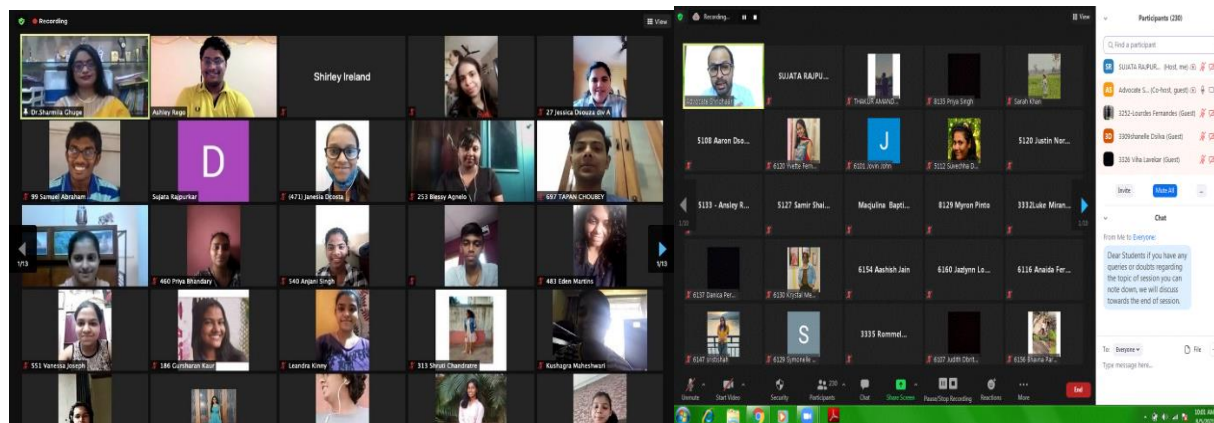
Library Orientation for First Year Degree Students

Book Exhibition

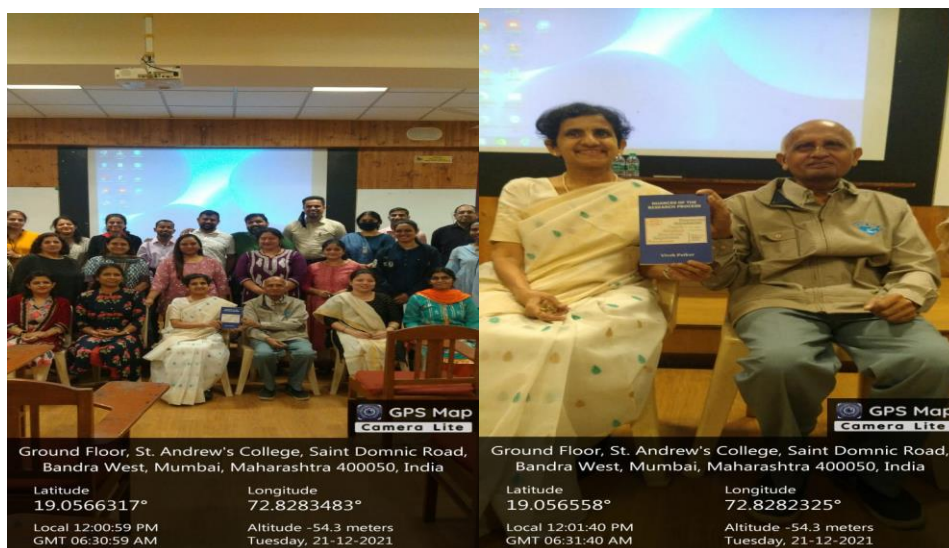
Exhibition of books in library was organized on 20 to 22 December 2021. Books published by various publishers were displayed for the exhibition. The whole purpose of exhibition was to make

Book Display

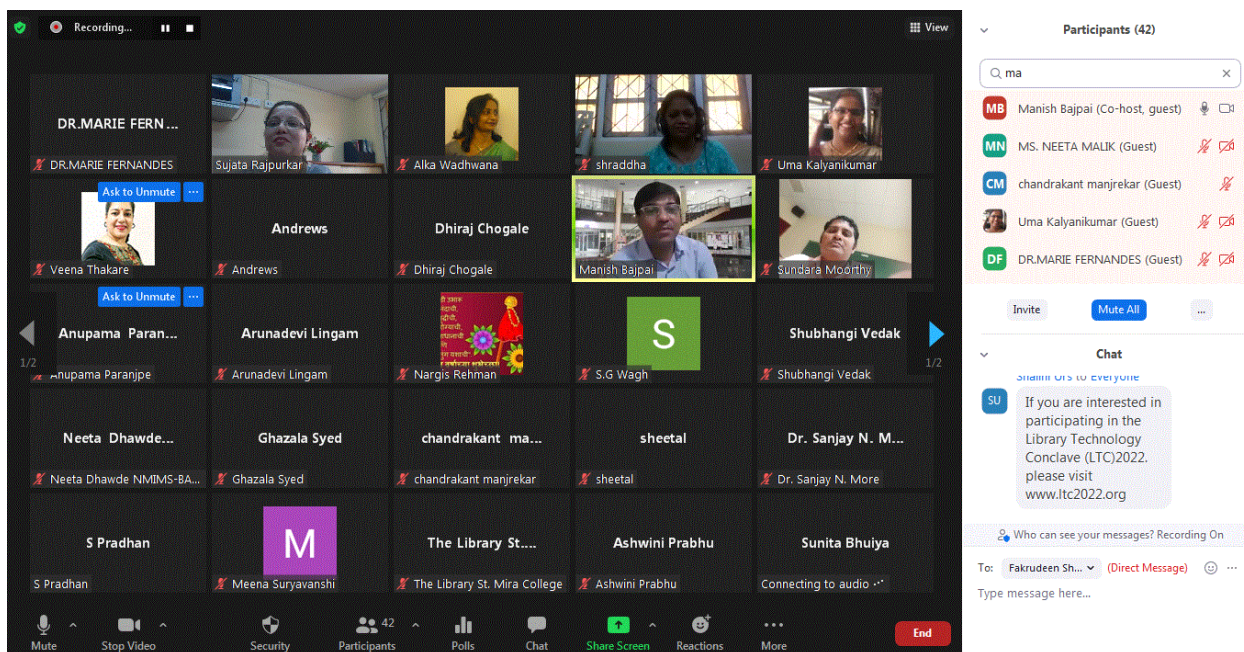
