Time tables for the ATKT and regular examinations – Aided and SFC -for September-October 2020 have been uploaded on the college website [www.standrewscollege.ac.in](http://www.standrewscollege.ac.in)

Students should note the following schedules:

- (1) Mock Test No.1: Wednesday, 23 September 2020 – all ATKT students (Aided and SFC) at 4.00 p.m.
- (2) Mock Test No.2: Saturday, 26 September 2020 – all Regular students UG (Aided and SFC) and PG 4.00 p.m.
- (3) Mock Test No.2: Thursday, 01 October 2020 – only UG students (Aided and SFC) 4.00 p.m.
- (4) Mock Test No.3: Saturday, 03 October 2020 – only PG students. 4.00 p.m.

Note that these tests are not subject specific. They are being undertaken so as to familiarise you with the experience of giving an on-line Multiple Choice Question examination.
