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Working across departments, programmes were organised with departments of History, English and Economics and Business Economics.

20 Aug 2019

Ms Samira Nadkarni from Department of English took a session on 'Black Feminism'.





22 July 2019

Dr Preeti Oza from Department of English engaged the students on the emergence and relevance of new ideologies in feminism. Her session was on Dalit Feminism and their contribution.

03 Dec 2019

The department in collaboration with the Department of History organised a student seminar. The theme was on 'Socio-Ecological movements.' The presentations mirrored the degradation of the environment and the loss of ethnic identity of the community who were or are still dependent on the environment. The presentation included the importance of the movements, the loopholes and the contingency plan to save the resources for the future generation.



The department in collaboration with the Departments of Economics and Business Economics organised a student seminar. The theme of the seminar was 'Marginalisation and Exclusion'. Dr. P.S. Vivek, Retired Faculty from the Department of Sociology, Mumbai University was invited as one of the resource person. His session started with the screening of the documentary 'Lesser Humans' which was documented based on the findings of his working conditions study on the exploitation of sanitation workers in Maharashtra and how the society delineate them from the mainstream world.



A syllabus revision workshop for the paper 'Introduction and Fundamentals of Sociology' was organised on 15 Jan 2020 by the department for the University of Mumbai undergraduate teachers under the aegis of Board of Studies, Department of Sociology. Prof Balaji Kendre, Chairperson BOS and Head Department of Sociology chaired the session.
