## Social Outreach Programme (Degree -Aided College) 2020-21

The Social Outreach Programme (SOP) in the Academic Year 2020-21 for degree college SYBA/BCOM students was conducted on an Online mode due to Covid 19 pandemic. Our implementing partner Ms. Deepika Singh helped us in designing the modules and implementing online mode of SOP. For this purpose a MOU was entered between Deepika Singh and the College.

18 SOP modules were designed by Ms. Deepika Singh which included themes such as Each One Teach One, Helping Aged, Covid 19 issues, Climate Change issues, Farm Laws and Anti Ragging

An online orientation programme was held for SYBCOM students in the last week of November, 2020 and for SYBA students in the first week of December, 2020 by the Profs. in Charge. Due to examination scheduled in December, 2020 orientation by Ms. Deepika Singh was held on January 6, 2021. At the orientation, students were informed about the SOP and detailed guidelines for completing online SOP were given to students.

After the orientation, students were asked to enroll for the SOP by selecting one theme from the modules designed by Deepika. Students were divided into groups of 15 from each division and according to the theme selected by them. A leader was appointed for each group to monitor and co-ordinate the programme.

After the SOP enrolment was completed, the actual SOP programme began by 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 A group leaders virtual meeting was held on Tuesday, February 23, 2021 to review the progress of SOP and to take feedback from students. Prof. Kevin Miranda organized the meeting and Prof. Janine Coelho and Ms Deepika Singh and 37 students representing various SOP groups attended the virtual meeting and gave in their feedback on the SOP.



Students have expressed happiness and sense of joy in doing the SOP especially talking to senior citizens in Home for the Aged over the phone. Some students had difficulties in doing their SOP which were resolved by Profs. In charge and Ms Deepika Singh. The students were asked to complete their SOP by 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 and submit reports and documentation through email to the Profs. In Charge.

A virtual meeting at 2 pm was held on 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 with students of SYBA/BCom to solve their doubts regarding completion of SOP and submission of reports. Both Prof. Kevin Miranda and Ms Deepika Singh attended the meeting and answered various queries and doubts raised by students from completion of SOP programme to writing and submission of reports. Those students who needed time to complete and submit to SOP reports were given extended time upto 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2021 to complete their SOP and submit their reports.



Out of the 491 students who enrolled for SOP, 474 students have submitted their SOP reports.
