c) Research, Innovations, and Extension

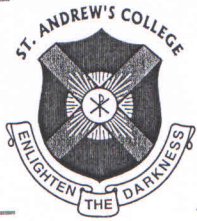
- To discuss extension activities linked to women empowerment.
