Criteria II – Teaching, Learning and Evaluation

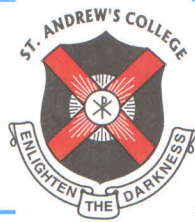
1. To discuss how online education can be made a more enriching experience for both educators and students.
