Instructions to Candidates for the On-Line Examinations

- 1. Login to https://lms.edflylearn.com/ for your examination 15 minutes before the examination time like you do each day for your lectures preferably from a laptop or through smart phone, switch on your camera and keep voice on mute.
- 2. If you cannot arrange for a laptop any device which has a camera to login for the exam, and use a second device to login for the examination using the link on the college website.

- 3. After that follow the steps that have been explained in the student manual –
- a. Login with your registered mobile number and password 123456 (this is a one time password, you will have to change it set a new password which you will use for the rest of the exams.
- b. After that you will have to login again and then you will have access to your examination.
- c. Click on Attempt to start the exam.
- 4. You will get 60 minutes to answer 50 Multiple Choice Questions. All questions are compulsory.
- 5. There are four options to each question. Select the most appropriate alternative by clicking on the bullet next to it.
- 6. When you select the option for a question, click on save and next. You get the next question.
- 7. You can always go back and change the answer if you want.
- 8. You can also choose to answer later by marking review later.
- 9. On the last question you will get a SUBMIT EXAM TAB. If you are confident you have answered all questions and don't want to review them click on the submit tab.
- 10. You will be asked to reconfirm you want to submit again. Click on submit exam and your exam will get submitted.

Please note:

- (1) If for some reason internet connectivity is suddenly lost. Re-login. You will be allowed to continue from the point where you left off.
- (2) Please note you will not be given any extra time.
- (3) Review all your answers before you finally submit your paper.
- (4) You cannot change your mind about any answers once the paper has been submitted.
- (5) There is no revaluation. .
- (6) Ensure that your laptops and cell phones are fully charged before the start of the exam with internet connectivity.
- (7) Ensure that you login only with the cell phone number officially registered with the college in the Google form.
