General library orientation was conducted for all the first-year students. Noteworthy achievement is Andrean Research Journal received eISSN: 2582-5143.

During the year membership with the American library and N-list database was continued, the Moodle server was updated with the latest question papers of all the courses and syllabus. Total 199 Students became a member of N-list database for their research work. Digital library updated with the latest collection. The addition of articles abstract and books abstract was continued in order to increase prompt retrieval of relevant documents. The facility of table of content service for the faculty members was continued. Language laboratory software upgraded and service was continued. Book bank service was provided to all the three years B.Com. Students. Total 54 students of the first, second and third year of B.Com. were benefited by this service. Students were permitted to retain book bank books with them throughout the entire semester. **Library Best User Award** was given to two students of the college for their better performance in the library. RFID work is still in progress.

#### New Books added to the collection:

During the year total **622** books have been added to the library collection, thus the total collection of the library is reached to **45809**. Total **27** subject journals, **26** magazines and eight English newspapers were subscribed by the library during the year.
