List of Activities 2020-21

- An orientation programme was conducted on 22nd October, 2020, for the registered students of the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE) unit. The students were briefed about DLLE and its objectives i.e., ‘reach the unreached.’ They were informed about the rules and regulations of DLLE and how important is their participation in the assignments and activities. The participants were introduced to their respective faculty and the student managers. They were given a list of activities that were conducted in previous years and were informed about the Extension Work Projects for the academic year 2020-21.
- An online workshop was conducted on the Google Meet Platform by MGNCRE on the topic “Social Entrepreneurship, Swachata and Rural Engagement” on 23rd October. The session covered topics like the evolution of social entrepreneurship, an explanation about the social entrepreneurs and a list of few reputed social entrepreneurs. A few videos regarding the topic were shown.
- Later, on 9th November, First Term Training was conducted by the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, University of Mumbai. The session covered the guidelines relating to the extension work. They gave directions on how the teachers in charge and the student managers should work in relation to the DLLE activities. Lists of activities to be performed were disclosed.
- On 28th November 2020, an online session on the Zoom platform was conducted for the DLLE participants on the topic “Failure is the Building Block to Success”. The speaker for the session was Mr. Sharat Sharma. He taught the audience, how to have an achiever’s mindset and learn from every failure to succeed in life.
- On 5th January, 2021, Every Nation Leadership conducted a Webinar titled– “Session on Identity”. The session began with Every Nation Leadership’s volunteer asking a few general questions and playing a small quiz. Later during the session, the participants were put into break-even rooms to discuss the general perception of our identity. The session was ended by a volunteer of Every Nation India giving their contact details for the participants to get in touch with the organization in case of any queries or guidance.
- On 8th January 2021, the students attended a Webinar on the Zoom platform on the topic “Social Responsibility and the Role of the Youth”. The speaker of the Webinar was Mr. Ameya Mahajan. He asked the participants to be actively involved in doing the activities that invoke our social responsibility as a youth towards the society.
- A Webinar was conducted on the Zoom platform on “Convert Your Dreams into Reality” by Mr. Anand Kumar on 9th January, 2021. He explained in detail the relationship between our thinking pattern and our achievement of goals. He spoke about the importance of having a vision board for achieving our goals.
- On 11th January 2021, an online session on the Zoom platform was organized on “Personality Development” which was conducted by Professor Sahil Naik. He guided

the participants on how important it is to make a good first impression and the various body postures and their interpretations.

- On the occasion of “Road Safety Week”, on 13th January 2021, the students participated in the digital poster making activity to bring awareness about road safety.
- Chef Akshata Shenoy conducted a live session on the Zoom platform on “Basic Bakery Skills” for the students on 19th January 2021. In the two hours session, she taught how to bake a brownie and chocolate chip cookies.
- The DLLE students attended an online session on 4th February, 2021, on the topic “Password Cracking and Preventions”. The speaker for the session was Mr. Rizwan Shaikh. The students were guided as to how to use strong passwords and ways and means to protect the passwords.
- To mark the occasion of International Women’s Day, on 8th March, 2021, the DLLE students took part in an activity named “Flavours of Sweetness” by preparing dessert and sharing it with the women in their family.
- Professor Savina Shenoy conducted a Webinar on the Zoom platform – “Session on Women Entrepreneurship” on 9th March, 2021. She showed videos of different famous women personalities like M. Kamalathal, Uppma Viridi, and Sudha Murthy among the few and encouraged the students to become Entrepreneurs.
- On 14th March 2021, an activity on CSR in Collaboration with the E-Cell and NSS unit of the college was conducted. They learnt about the difficulties and achievements of small business owners and helped them promote their business on social media platforms.
- On 15th March 2021, the students participated in an activity i.e., Plant – A – Plant. The main motto behind the activity was to help students imbibe the importance of plants and nature and to help the environment heal by doing our bit.
- On 17th March 2021, students participated in a Content Creative Writing. The participants were given a few topics to select from and were asked to submit their creative work in PDF format or the Word file. This activity helped the students to enhance their content writing skills.
- On 18th March, 2021, an activity named “Mindful Art” was conducted for the DLLE students. The topic for the Mindful Art was Mandala. The students submitted their work through PNG/JPEG format.
- The DLLE students participated in an activity named “Art on A Mask” on 19th March 2021. The theme for the activity was nature and the environment.
- On 20th March, they participated in - “Reel the Creativity” activity. The theme for the activity was best out of waste. To celebrate Earth Day, poem writing activity was conducted. The poems were submitted via a link in a PNG/JPEG format.
- On 14th April 2021, an activity was organised for the DLLE students on the topic “Earth Day Awareness – Your Views Matter”. The students were sent videos about the earth and related topics prior to the event and later during the session, they spoke about their videos and expressed their views on how one can help save our Earth for the current and future generations.

- On 15th April, 2021, the students took part in an event namely “World Heritage Day” by making an infographic poster of their native place or any other destination of their choice.
- On 15th and 16th April, 2021, an online workshop was conducted for the DLLE students on the topic “Advanced Excel”. Prof. Prashant Tari spoke about the various equations and functions of Excel and Dr. Priya Shahi taught the VLOOKUP function, HLOOKUP function and the Pivot Table.
