

Avishkar Research Convention

The Avishkar Research Convention was initiated by the Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra and the Chancellor of the Universities in the State of Maharashtra in the academic year 2007-2008. The convention is designed with the intention to develop a research culture and scientific temper among the students, scholars and teachers from under-graduate to doctoral level in the state of Maharashtra.

In 2020-2021 given COVID-19, it was not possible to organise Avishkar Research Convention as per regular mode. So, to keep the temperament of the research, the Board of Students' Development, University of Mumbai decided to conduct this research activity on Virtual Platform. In the selection round, the research proposals were invited online. A total of 7 teams participated from St. Andrew's College in the Selection Round in the categories of Humanities, Commerce and Management.

To encourage the students to participate in research activities at inter-collegiate, district, university and state levels, an online orientation session was conducted on 10 November 2020 by Dr. Madhu Rai. To promote the interaction among the students for the exchange of various aspects of Research, power point presentation round was organised for the participants via Zoom Platform on 4 March 2021.
