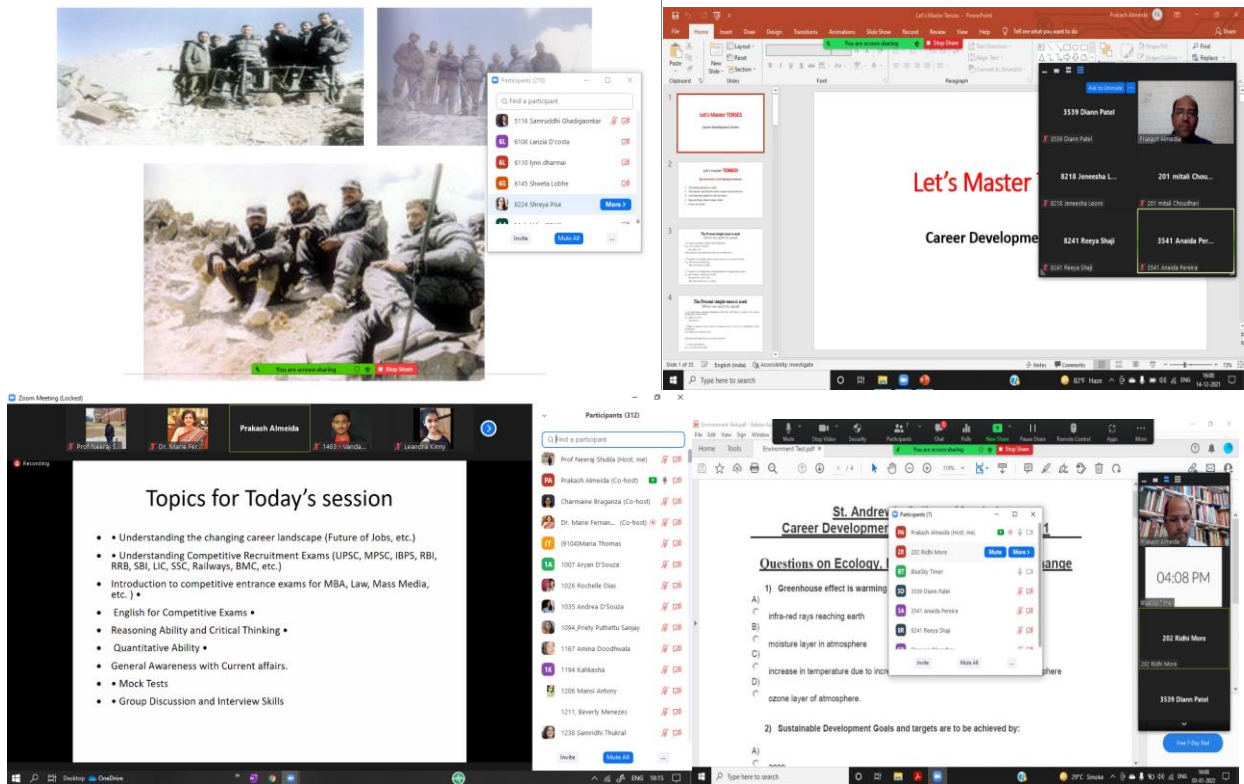


CIVIL SERVICES REPORT 2021-22

- The Civil services cells organised various events for the academic year 2021-22. The events were planned such that maximum of our students would learn and opt for competitive exams.
- A workshop was organised on 10th May'2021 and 11th May'2021 Conducted by Mr Prakash Almeida of CareerPrep in which 312 Students Participated and learnt about various Modules involved in various Competitive exams and how to tackle.
- A course of 25 sessions each of 1 Hour 30 minutes was started on 27th May 2021 to 2nd JULY 2021. A comprehensive training was provided to 18 students on all the domains of competitive exams by CareerPrep Course. Total 45 Hours of Sessions were done.
- An orientation was organised on "Kargil Diwas" 26/07/2021 in which 210 students participated, students were informed about the Kargil war and also they were motivated to join the defence forces to serve the country.
- Motivational talk on "Career through Competitive Exams" was taken by Mr Prakash Almeida from Career Development Centre. Total 36 students participated for the same.
- A course of 25 sessions each of 1 Hour 30 minutes was started on 8th DEC 2021 to 28th JAN 2022. A comprehensive training was provided on all the domains of competitive exams by CareerPrep Course. Total 18 students undertook the course. Total 45 Hours of Sessions were done
- Three day course on "Career Pathways-Ignite your Career", was conducted from 14th Feb 22 to 18th Feb 22 by CareerPrep institute in which 63 students from various streams participated. Students also gave Mock test at the end and received their certificates.
- A comprehensive Mock test on banking, Civil Services was conducted throughout the academic year from June 2021 to March 2022 covering past papers and current affairs, students attempted these Mock test and immediately got their marks, and also correct answers for the same. There were 15 Mock test with average participation of 150 Students



CIVIL SERVICES REPORT 2019-20

- On eve of Kargil day- 26.7.2019, Civil Service Cell organised a session on Life in Defence of a Nation by General K.S. Brar. The session coverage included insights on Operation Blue Star along with motivation to join Army.164 students from BCom, BA and Self - Financed courses attended the session.
- On 24 August 2019 and 26 August 2019, Civil Service Orientation sessions were conducted by Mr. Prakash Almeida to motivate students to become Civil Service aspirants for entering into Government Jobs. The sessions gave basics of Competitive Recruitment exams like Banking, Insurance and Staff Selection along with Civil Services. Elton (TYBCOM -A) assisted in co-ordinating the sessions for different classes. 55 students from Degree Section attended the orientation session.
- On 20th Feb 2020, Civil Service Cell organised National IAS Talent Search Exam 2020 in collaboration with ALS Satellite Education pvt. ltd. The exam gave students hands on experience for appearing IAS Prelims (Mock) test. 142 Degree college students appeared for the test.

- On Feb 6, 2020, Civil Service Cell organised a Talk on 'Police and Youth' jointly in association with the NSS unit. Eminent speakers invited were Padma Sri Chaman Lal, an Ex- IPS (who served as an IGP In-charge and Director of BSF Academy) and Padma Bhusan - Mr Julio Ribeiro, Ex-Commissioner of Police, Mumbai. They reflected their views to sensitize students with functions and practical aspects of joining the Police force. Rightly remarked: Bravery – Not only a sense of fear but an action in face of fear was the takeaway from the talk ending with a sense of motivation and encouragement among students to join Civil Services. 65 students from Degree section attended the event.
