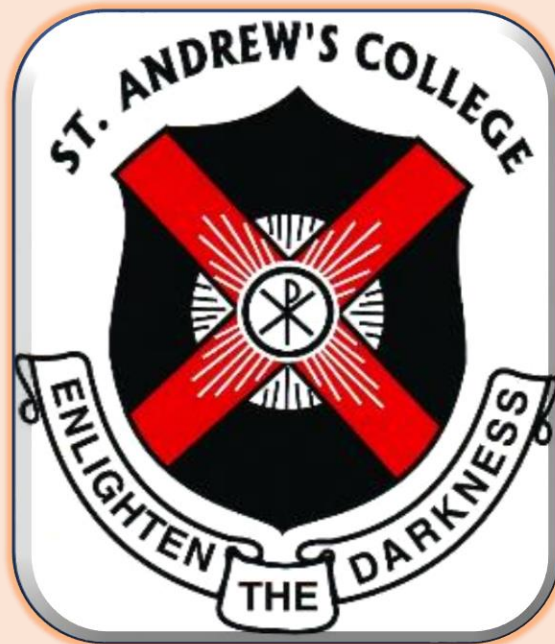


The College Crest
