Activities of the Andrean Psychology Team 2021-22

The Andrean Psychology Team celebrated the 'International Left Hander's Day' on the 12th August 2021, to debuff myths about handedness and create awareness about lateralization of brain functions. On the 7th September, 2021 a panel discussion was organised on the topic 'Redefining relationships in the 21st Century'. This discussion helped the students engage in high cognitive and affective level discussions wherein the multidimensionality of the topic was explored. The panel consisted of ten students from varied backgrounds and 63 students participated in this discussion.

On the 10th September, 2021 the team celebrated 'International Suicide Prevention Day' in order to create awareness about suicide and mental health. The objective of the seminar was to encourage students to seek help during mental health crisis. The team also celebrated 'International Alzheimer's Day' on the 21st September, 2021 to create awareness about Alzheimer's, and its causes, detection, treatment and rehabilitation.

In order to educate our students about classical psychology experiments and lay its foundations, the students were shown screenings of Milgram's destructive obedience research conducted in 1965. This social psychology experiment helped lay foundations for a deeper understanding into research and scientific progress. This also helped cultivate interest amongst students to take up interest in the annual 'Avishkar Research Competition' conducted by Mumbai University and Intra-Collegiate Annual Research Competition.


Two student groups participated in the Avishkar competition. Ms. Disha Kulkarni conducted a qualitative research study on eating disorders amongst adolescents. She conducted a thematic analysis on the subjective reality of individuals who had posted on various internet forums and social media sites such as Reddit and Tumblr. The second team consisted of Ms. Marilyn Braganza and Ms. Yocheved-Marie Leo who conducted a quantitative analysis on the varied grieving styles of people during the pandemic induced lockdown.

In the intra-collegiate competition, our psychology team won the first prize and their research paper was selected to be published in the college research journal which had an e-ISSN. The team consisted of Ms. Marilyn Braganza, Ms. Yocheved-Marie Leo and Ms. Valentina Pinto, they conducted a quantitative analysis on the mental health of working women during the pandemic. They explored the role conflict that working mothers experienced between work and household demands, and how that adversely impacted their mental health.

The Andrean Psychology team organised a debate on the topic 'A digital life post covid is healthy' on the 1st February, 2022. Two student teams of 5 members each participated in it. It helped students to reason well thought out arguments through analysis of information and indepth research. Soon afterwards on 5th February, a guest lecture on the topic 'The pandemic connect-crossroads of spirituality and mental health' was conducted by renowned psychotherapist Dr. Dinu Shibu Mathew in association with UNESCO and CPP Chair. This session helped present an authentic and vivid picture of the pandemic and its impact on mental health by a professional, thereby imbibing in students a path of life-long learning.

The Andrean Psychology Team organised the inter-collegiate contest 'Cinemania: A Research Challenge'. It helped develop their analytical skills related to accurate/inaccurate depictions of psychological disorders, treatment and the impact on the viewers about mental health and therapy. Cinemania was such a success, that all the research papers presented were to be published in an ISBN book by the name 'The Cinemania – The Monograph'. This will further bolster the credentials of student's CVs and help them in their future endeavours.




