MALPRACTICE NOTICE

Students indulging in **Examination Malpractice**/s will be dealt with as per the Ordinance No. 220 of the University of Mumbai.

Malpractice refers to:

- a) Attempt to copy from others
- b) Copy from others
- c) Intention to copy by bringing inside the examination hall material written on:
 - i) Paper
 - ii) Palms or hands
 - iii) Writing pads
 - iv) Printed materials, books
 - v) In any other form or means

PENALTY: 1) The result of the entire examination will be treated as null and void.

- 2) Will not be allowed to appear for the examination for minimum of one year to a maximum of three years.
- P.S. The above penalty is also applicable to those students who allow others to copy from their answer books or help them copy in any other manner.

<u>Please note that if students fail in any subject they can appear for the next A.T.K.T</u> <u>examination of that subject. However, if students are caught using Unfair Means the entire examination will be considered as null and void.</u>

- Students are asked to check their compass/pen/pencil box, desk, bench, place below and around their seat and pick up any piece of paper or any other material and drop it in the dustbin before the commencement of the examination every day.
- Students should check any matter written on their desk/bench. Anything related to the Examination paper should be reported to the supervisor immediately. Failure to do so will be treated as using 'Unfair Means' in the examination and dealt with as per the rules.
- Students should strictly follow the instructions of the supervisor during the examination without fail.

Cell phones and any other electronic devices are not permitted inside the examination hall.
